The 2023 edition of the Hocking Hills Twist Tour (HT2) is in the books with 12 riders including 3 couples. Although first time event rider, Steve Kineman, tried to jinx us by saying "The weather is going to be perfect" over and over again, he was right and we had perfect weather for the whole event. The mornings were comfortably cool but by 10 am we were taking off an extra layer and we were opening our vents in the early afternoon. The only thing we could remotely complain about was the mid-80's temperature in the afternoon as we rode home on Sunday.

Everyone seemed to enjoy the routes and the restaurants with Miller's Chicken being one of those funky building/tasty food spots that made it a favorite lunch stop.

Overall, the roads are good with mostly good surface and a variety of medium to fast curves. One irony was that the roads keep the average speed up which is good when you are expecting hot weather, but the very comfortable temperatures left some of us wishing for more 2<sup>nd</sup> gear turns. Of course, there are always problems. We had an unexpected bridge out which closed a road and caused a bit of circling. There was also a section of road where the attempts to fix it only seemed to make it worse. But that happens and there will be route tweaks for next year.



On Friday, the roads were very quiet with little traffic to deal with, but more passes were made on Saturday. Happily, most drivers were friendly, even waving us past. No performance awards earned, and the only motorcycle work was on discovering a ticking sound from Paul's chain with a full government quota of supervisors standing around drinking beer.

The hotel in Logan was comfortable and friendly. The good news is that they seemed to like us too. I met with the manager on Saturday, and she offered a really good room block rate for next year. Once we get a contract completed, I will be announcing it and I highly recommend booking early.

Finally, I can report one bird committed suicide on Wes' fairing, multiple deer crossed the road in front of or between riders, my "ground hog in the road" count was in the dozens, and I saw more than 10 turtles trying to cross the road.



# 2023 Michigan That's... Unique Grand Tour

The grand tour returns for 2023. The theme this year will be unique things to see in Michigan and will be called the 2023 Michigan That's... Unique Grand Tour. It will once again take you all over the lower peninsula and the upper peninsula, to give you a good chance to enjoy some of the things that Michigan has to offer. As in the past, this is an event to do at your own pace, on your own schedule, alone or with one or more friends. You can visit as many of the checkpoints as your time and energy permit. When visiting a checkpoint, you will simply take a photo of your motorcycle with the Grand Tour sign and the checkpoint behind as shown in the photo, and then send your photos to me for proof of your visit.



Basically, the grand tour is simply 14 destinations, and an excuse to get out on your motorcycle and ride around our great lake state. If you think you might like to participate but don't know if you will find the time to do all 14 checkpoints, sign up to receive the information packet anyway. There's no obligation to visit any checkpoints, just a lot of great places to go and things to see if you do.

At the end of the year, we'll tally up the results, and give awards at the MOTY banquet to participants who completed the grand tour.

The grand tour will run until November 19.

Day 1 of UNCR IV begins on Thursday, July 13<sup>th</sup> with a ride to Port Huron, across the Bluewater Bridge and up the Bruce Peninsula to Tobermory, Ontario. We then enjoy an evening Chi-Chi-Man ferry voyage to Manitoulin Island, camping at a dark sky preserve just north of our debarkation point at South Baymouth. Day 2 and we work our way up to Wawa, Ontario via a curvy back country route. Day 3 sees us working around the top of Lake Superior to Grand Portage, Minnesota. Day 4 and we enjoy a day trip to Isle Royale National Park. Days 5 & 6 and we're riding across the UP of Michigan.

The short version ends on Sunday, July 15<sup>th</sup> which will see riders leaving Wawa and riding south to Sault Ste Marie, crossing the international border and heading home.










