

MSTR Mileage Program

The MSTR Mileage Program lets MSTRiders compare their yearly motorcycle mileage with their fellow riders.

This is an honorary program. Send me an email to let me know you plan to participate in 2025 and then simply record your starting and ending mileage for the year. As a reminder, two or three times throughout the year, I'll send you an email request to submit your latest mileage. I'll reply to each mileage e-mail you submit within a week or so. If you participated in previous years I'll include an update on your past mileages, including highest, lowest, average, etc.

At the end of the year I'll compile everyone's mileages and create a mileage chart, which will be displayed at the 2025 MOTY (Member Of The Year) banquet. Depending on your mileage you could win an award, recognizing the female and male rider with the most average mileage and the female and male rider with the highest mileage.

You must be a 2025 MSTR member to participate. The following can be submitted:

- Mileage from January 1st, 2025 thru to December 31st, 2025
- All miles ridden on the street or dirt on any motorcycle with a license plate. This includes rentals anywhere in the world
- All race track mileages on a plated motorcycle - think track days on your motorcycle
- Race track mileage on a dedicated track bike is excluded
- MOTY points will be awarded with 3 points each to the most average mileage female and male rider and 2 points each to the highest mileage female and male rider

If you participated in 2024 let me know if you need your mileage or odometer readings and I'll send them to you.

You can either send in your total miles ridden or your starting and ending odometer readings for each motorcycle. Since some people may have multiple motorcycles you'll need to identify the miles or odometer values for each motorcycle by whatever method you prefer (model name and year, bike A, B, C, etc.)

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
