

## 2026 Michigan Bridges Grand Tour



In your travels, you have undoubtedly crossed many (literal) bridges, many of which have been unique or historical in some way, but have you ever given them a second thought? Well, this year, you can give 14 bridges, and many others, multiple thoughts as you plan out your rides, and see and cross over bridges.

This year's Grand Tour focuses on bridges around Michigan. Some are pedestrian bridges, some are kind of old, some are rather new, but all are unique in some way.

For this year's Grand Tour, you will visit 14 bridges, including eight in the lower peninsula and 6 in the upper peninsula. They're spread out so you can get out and see as much of our great state as you care to see (or don't care to see). There will also be a few extra credit suggestions for you, and in a different twist, there will also be three extra credit suggestions OUTSIDE of Michigan.

As in the past, we'll have awards for Grand Tourers, Baby Grand Tourers, and Trolls (for those who have to stay below the bridge). You can also earn up to 42 extra credits for special recognition as a Grand Tourer PRO at the annual MOTY banquet. Extra credits can include other bridges, attractions, scenic spots, historical spots, unique restaurants, or whatever else you find that is uniquely Michigan. As mentioned above, I'm also suggesting a couple of additional historic bridges in West Virginia and Ohio, and I may allow other unique or historic bridges outside of Michigan as well.

The Grand Tour runs from March 28 to near the end of the year. It's done at your convenience, in any order, by yourself or with friends, and as quickly or slowly as you like. There are no prescribed routes, just 14 checkpoints. It's basically an excuse with a destination to go for a ride on your motorcycle.
